Our big new work of the year was Wilderness Plan. We were invited back by [openhousenewyork](http://openhousenewyork.com), after the success of The Crane Wife at Pier 66, to perform another site-specific work for their 10th annual weekend of architectural events.. We selected the Elevated Acre at 55 Water Street, where the choreography was inspired by the interaction of nature and architecture at the site. The audience followed the dancers and percussionist up the stairs, down the path, on to the boardwalk and to the risers, as the performers illuminated each of the areas with their music and dancing. The performance culminated with a signature C. Eule Dance workshop where audience members got to explore their own interpretations of nature and architecture through movement.
